



WINGS OVER BOTSWANA 7 DAYS – FLYING SAFARI OVER BOTSWANA



Botswana's wilderness areas are pristine and cover everything from sparse desert to inland delta. The Okavango, Botswana's best known feature, is the world's largest inland delta comprising thousands of channels that empty into the Kalahari Desert. Moremi and Chobe are Botswana's two other major wildlife sanctuaries and should not be missed. Our Wings Over Botswana is the ideal journey through Botswana visiting Okavango, Moremi and Chobe wildlife sanctuaries, staying at small, intimate safari lodges and camps linked by light aircraft flights. Each camp is completely self contained and wildlife viewing activities are conducted in open vehicles or boats on the delta, together with walking safaris with your camp guide.

DAY 1 + 2

CHOBE

Morning arrival in Maun, Botswana where you will be met and assisted to your light aircraft flight to Savute Safari Lodge, a luxury lodge in the Savute channel inside Chobe National Park. Your timber, glass and thatch chalet has a private viewing deck and you will enjoy two days of game viewing activities in special open vehicles in search of the "big cats" with your camp guide.

SAVUTE SAFARI LODGE (B,L,D)

DAY 3 + 4

MOREMI

Morning light aircraft flight to Camp Moremi, situated in the Moremi Wildlife Reserve. Your luxury tent has twin beds with private bathroom. The main treehouse overlooking the Xakanaxa lagoon houses the dining area, the 'lookout bar', library and lounge. Enjoy two days of escorted game viewing by open safari vehicles or on foot with your camp guide.

CAMP MOREMI (B,L,D)



DAY 5 + 6

OKAVANGO

An early morning game drive, return for breakfast and depart by light aircraft for Camp Okavango, built on an island deep in the heart of the Okavango delta. Camp Okavango offers the same luxury tented facilities as Camp Moremi. Two days of fully escorted game viewing by 'mokoro' (canoe) or walking on a nearby island. Fishing is also available on the delta.

DAY 7

DEPARTURE

A final early morning of game viewing activity. Breakfast and return flight to Maun where you will connect with your onward flight. (B)
