



WINGS OVER NAMIBIA 8 DAYS – AN EXCITING JOURNEY BY LIGHT AIRCRAFT



Namibia is a wild and desolate country containing some of the most unique landscapes on the planet. This exciting journey by light aircraft travels from Windhoek, the capital, to the edge of the Kalahari Desert, the magnificent Sossusvlei sand dunes, the cold and barren Skeleton coast and finally the Etosha wildlife sanctuary before returning to Windhoek. Covering the vast distances by light aircraft is the only way to travel and you will stay at small hotels and safari lodges, offering a very personal service. Our Wings Over Namibia is the perfect safari for the second time adventurous visitor to Africa.

DAY 1 WINDHOEK

Arrive in Windhoek, Namibia where you will be met and escorted to your small, luxury inn near the city. A welcome briefing with the rest of the day at leisure.

DAY 2 FISH RIVER CANYON

Transfer to the airport and board your light aircraft, flying along the edge of the Kalahari desert to the magnificent boulder studded plains and hills of the Fish River Canyon. Transfer on arrival to your safari lodge with the afternoon free to explore the nature trail.
CANON LODGE (B,D)

DAY 3 SOSSUSVLEI

Morning excursion to the spectacular rim of the Fish River Canyon before boarding your aircraft for a scenic flight over the sand dunes of the Namib desert. Arrive at Sesriem and transfer to your lodge with the afternoon at leisure.
SOSSUSVLEI LODGE (B,D)

DAY 4 SWAKOPMUND

A very early breakfast and depart for the Sossusvlei sand dunes, the world's highest, arriving in time for sunrise. Continue through the heart of the Namib desert to the Sesriem Canyon to explore the gorges. Board your aircraft and fly along the harsh and barren Atlantic coastline to the holiday town of Swakopmund. Enjoy dinner at one of the many restaurants in town.
HOTEL HANSA (B)

DAY 5 DAMARALAND

Travel to Walvis Bay for a cruise to view marine and birdlife and enjoy the fresh local oysters. Return to Swakopmund and fly over the Skeleton coast to Damaraland, where steep mountains tower over ancient riverbeds. This is the home of the rare desert elephant and you transfer on arrival to your safari lodge.
TWYFELFONTEIN COUNTRY LODGE (B,D)

DAY 6 ETOSHA

Morning visit to the ancient rock art site at Twyfelfontein before flying to the Etosha National Park in northern Namibia. Transfer on arrival to your safari lodge with the afternoon to relax and enjoy the spa facilities.
TALENI ETOSHA VILLAGE (B,D)

DAY 7 ETOSHA

A full day game viewing drive in the Etosha National Park, home to a multitude of animal species of the Southern African savannah plains, exploring the numerous waterholes and salt pans where wildlife congregates. Late afternoon return to your safari lodge.
TALENI ETOSHA VILLAGE (B,D)

DAY 8 DEPART WINDHOEK

Breakfast and board your aircraft for the flight to Windhoek, with transfer on arrival to the International airport for your onward flight. (B)
