THE GARDEN ROUTE

Day 1 Morning scenic drive from Port Elizabeth to the Storms River Gorge, through the Tsitsikamma forest and Nature’s valley to Plettenberg Bay, a scenic seaside resort. Arrive late afternoon at Knysna.

Day 2 Morning ferry ride to the Featherbed Nature Reserve. Enjoy a nature walk and lunch. Afternoon cruise back to Knysna.

Day 3 Travel along the Outeniqua Pass to Oudtshoorn, the ostrich capital of the world. Guided tour of an ostrich farm followed by a visit to the Cango Caves.

THE SHAMWARI SAFARI

Shamwari is a fifty thousand acre, malaria free, private wildlife sanctuary in the Eastern Cape, an hour from Port Elizabeth. There are six separate safari lodges within Shamwari and each one offers a unique style of accommodation and cuisine. Shamwari’s team of expert guides will escort every wildlife activity and introduce guests to some of the research projects that run within the sanctuary.

The Rovos Rail is the most luxurious train in the world, and operates various journeys throughout Africa. A maximum of seventy two passengers travel in three cabin categories – Pullman suites, Deluxe suites & Royal suites. Pretoria to Durban (2 nights/3 days) – Journey from Pretoria through the spectacular Drakensburg mountains. Arrive the next morning for an early morning game viewing drive in Kruger National Park. Continue to the kingdom of Swaziland for a late game viewing drive followed by an outdoor dinner. Overnight journey to Zululand for game viewing in the Hluhluwe Nature Reserve before arriving in Durban.

Pretoria to Cape Town (2 nights/3 days) – A unique journey through South Africa from Pretoria to Cape Town, crossing the Great Karroo desert, and meandering through the wineries of the Cape to the foot of Table Mountain in Cape Town. Includes a visit to the Kimberley diamond mine.

Pretoria to Victoria Falls (2 nights/3 days) – This exciting journey takes you from Pretoria to Victoria Falls. The train journey travels through the Drakensberg mountains. Game viewing in the Hwange National Park and continue to Victoria Falls.

Cape Town to Dar es Salaam (12 Nights/13 Days) – Journey through South Africa, Zimbabwe, Zambia and Tanzania. It is destined to become the most famous rail journey in the world, including visits to Kimberley, Pretoria, the Kruger National Park, Bulawayo, Victoria Falls, Lusaka, the Luangwa Valley and the Tanzam Railway into the historical city of Dar es Salaam.
