Wildlife Safari has selected the five finest private wildlife concessions in this region and features the few excellent safari lodges and camps contained within these properties. SINGITA is the benchmark for all private safari lodges & camps surrounding Kruger National Park. Singita rightly deserves its “best safari lodge in the world” accolade as no expense has been spared on each suite. Singita has two separate lodges, Boulders and Ebony, both have identical levels of very personal service and outstanding cuisine. The wildlife biodiversity, game viewing experience and guide expertise is commensurate with its world’s best accolade.

ROYAL MALEWANE, on the western fringe of Kruger, welcomes a maximum of just twenty guests. It’s the exclusive escape for those seeking privacy, personal service and some of the best wildlife viewing. Each suite has a private pool and is linked by elevated walkway to the other guest areas. The cuisine is world class while expert game rangers will tailor make your wildlife activities in the private sanctuary.

KAPAMA is situated in the heart of a thirteen thousand hectare wildlife sanctuary in Limpopo Province. The main lodge overlooks a tranquil lake with a deck of bird watching and guests stay in well equipped thatched roof chalets. The Drakensberg Mountains provide a spectacular backdrop to Kapama River Lodge, which is one of the largest in the Kruger region. Buffalo Camp is small and exclusive with just eight large tents on raised platforms among the treetops.

SABI SABI is one of the finest private wildlife sanctuaries with three unique safari lodges. Bush Lodge overlooks a floodlit waterhole, Earth Lodge is an intimate property in the heart of the bushveld and Selati Lodge is designed with an early 20th century luxury theme. Game viewing by open four wheel drive vehicles are escorted by expert guides and trackers. Night game drives and escorted bush walks are included.

LION SANDS is situated in the southern Kruger region and is the only property to have full access to the Sable River. The density and diversity of wildlife within this private wildlife sanctuary is amazing and numerous game viewing activities are really the experience of a lifetime. The safari lodge offers excellent accommodations with an unforgettable culinary journey and service at value that is second to none.
